LOUGH-DERG VIRTUAL PILGRIMAGE Bishop McKeown is inviting people to join him on Friday 29 May from St Eugene's Cathedral, Derry where he will lead his second 24 hour 'virtual pilgrimage', to fast and pray, asking God: to free us from this pandemic and to support those who are fighting it; to comfort those who have been affected with this pandemic; and to ask God for the wisdom to know how to live now and in the aftermath of the pandemic. This time of prayer and penance at home will take its shape from core elements of the 3-day Lough Derg pilgrimage. The day will start with 6 am Mass, Seven Stations through the 24 period and conclude with 6 am Mass on Saturday 30 May.
